	We ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups, this includes ensuring that the needs of socially disadvantaged pupils are adequately assessed and addressed .									
	In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognise that not all pupils who receive free school meals will be socially disadvantaged.									
	We also recognise that not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals.									
	Pupil premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups or individuals.									
<b>Provision</b>	All our work through the Pupil Premium was aimed at accelerating progress moving children to at least age related expectations.									
	Providing small group work with an experienced teacher or TA focused on overcoming gaps in learning for numeracy and literacy across the school varied according to needs.									
	Ongoing computer intervention to support literacy - Lexia.									
	Booster Teacher in Year 6 to provide support and extension.									
	Year 1 booster phonics group 5 times a week, before school.									
	All children on the Pupil Premium register are offered a school club on a termly basis from September 2017.									
	Nurture support TA for three afternoons a week to support social, emotional and mental health difficulties.
