

ST MARY'S STATUTORY ASSESSMENT RESULTS 2013

In addition to continuous assessment, the school annually conducts assessment of Year 2 pupils and administers the national Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6 pupils).

Key Stage 1 Teacher Assessment covers Mathematics, Reading, Writing and Spelling. Level 2 is designed to challenge a typical seven year old. Key Stage 2 SATs cover Mathematics and English. These test papers are sent off to be marked by external examiners. Level 4 is designed to challenge a typical eleven year old and is the National Standard for children at the end of Key Stage 2. Level 5 is the standard expected for the average 13 year old. Level 6 is the standard for the average 14/15 year old.

Individual results of assessment are reported to the child's parents.

EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE 2013

We were very pleased with the results achieved by our children at the end of Foundation Stage in July. In all areas of the Early Years curriculum they exceeded the National Averages.

Provisional EYFS 81% (national = 59%) met language goals 87% (national =72%) met maths goals. National figures in parenthesis. Additionally, 33% exceeded language goals and 38% exceeded maths goals.

We are delighted with these excellent results and congratulations to all pupils, teachers and teaching assistants.
