

# Spring Term 2018




# Reception

-  The Emergency Services. ~ This will include a trip to Welwyn Fire Station (date to be arranged later).




If there is anyone who could talk to the children about their work as part of this topic, we would welcome you with open arms, especially anyone involved in the emergency services. Please let us know.

- Please continue to read with your child for a short period every day. Your child will not only benefit from reading to you but also from hearing you read to them.




