Discussing Bonfire night and safety around fireworks. Hearing the story of Christmas and discussing advent and the importance for Christians.

Learn about St Andrew's day and the origin.

Learn about Joseph and the technicoloured dream coat.

<u>Understanding the world – spring 2</u>

Learning about St David's Day and St Patrick's Day and how Welsh and Irish people celebrate. Make Welsh cakes and soda bread.

Looking at growth and how we have changed over time.

Learn the Easter story, how Christian's celebrate and why this is an important celebration.
