1. **Minutes of the last meeting** – the minutes of the last AGM meeting on the 17<sup>th</sup> September 2019 were accepted as a true and accurate record.

**3. Treasurers Report:** April 2019 – March 2020 – details shared of budgets and income coming in on a regular basis in to the School Fund. As at 31/03/20 the balance of the School Fund bank account was £2501. 13 families have already kindly committed to making regular donations. Approximately £130 per month is donated via direct debits. Gift Aid was collected for missing past years which generated £1500.

**4. Chair's Report:** The money for the mosaic project will be carried forward to next year, when the project can be up and running again. In the meantime the school could make use of new Lego bibles and new toys for the outdoor play boxes for the year bubbles. In addition it was hoped that more interest and regular donations could be generated for the School Fund at a time when fundraising for the PTFA is fundamentally more difficult. For people who want to and are able to donate financially, promoting the School Fund charity could possibly see an increase in the number of regular donations.
