

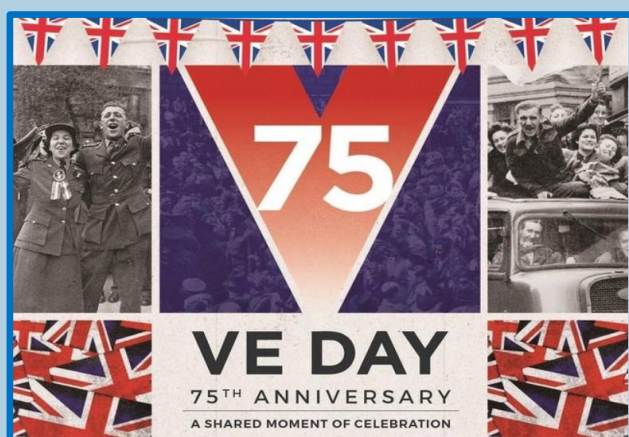


Hi everyone!

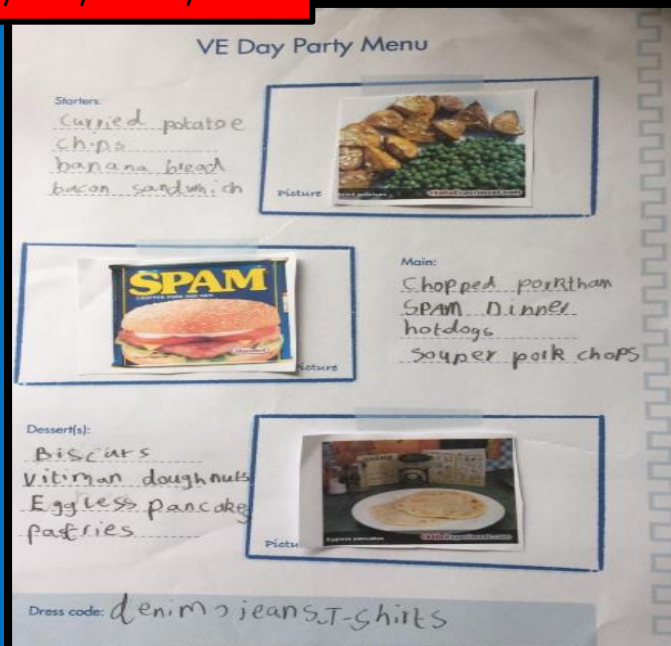
