Maths Games

## Play four in a Row

- Fill the grid with numbers between 1-20
- Take turns to make a number using addition subtraction or a combination of both
- If your answer is correct cross off your number
- First to cross off four in a row wins the game


## Play 21's

- Play with a partner
- The aim is to force your partner to 21
- If they say 21 they lose the game
- First player Start on either 1,2 or 3
- Second player add on either 1, 2 or 3 to the number chosen
- Players continue to decide to add on 1,2 or 3 each time increasing the

Number until someone is forced to say 21.

## Play High Roller

- You will need some dice
- Counters
- Take turns to roll a dice 3 times
- Total the three digits rolled
- Whoever has the highest total wins a counter
- First to 5 counters wins the game
- Extend the game by playing to 10 counters
- Extend by rolling the dice 4 or 5 times and totalling to find the score.
